For full credit, write out homework completely. The writing practice is useful. Assume that exercises are to be turned in unless the schedule says otherwise.

Time limit for oral recitation: 45 seconds. This recitation is part of your final exam grade. It will count for 5% of the final exam grade. You can do تمرين ١٩ in your book to prepare for the text rewriting and the recitation but it will not be assigned as homework to turn in.

Spend about 45 minutes reading the text and answering the comprehension questions based on it in تمرين ١٥. Write the answers in your book. Do as much as you can.

Record yourself reading the paragraph in تمرين ١٧. This reading will be worth 5% of the final exam grade and is due Wednesday. It is an audio only assignment. Time limit for the reading is 60 seconds. Pay attention to correct reading of إضافات and to the pronunciation of ال with words beginning with sun letters. Be sure that you understand the text so that your "chunking" of the text and your intonation reflect the meaning. Make your reading fluent by reading strings of words together with elision (not pausing between words). There is a model reading at the OLE conference "Elementary Arabic All Sections".

The final exam time for each section is on the semester schedule at the class website.

Your final exam is worth only 15% of your semester grade. However, remember the following from the grading policy on the class syllabus:

In general, the final grade will not be more that 10 percentage points higher than the result on the final exam. Thus, a student with a semester average of 81%, but a final exam grade of 65%, will receive a C for their final grade.

As long as you prepare for the final exam, your performance on that exam should be within 10 percentage points of your average in the class. Preparing for the final is an opportunity to do one final review of all that you have learned this semester and an opportunity to demonstrate the fruits of all your hard work this semester and I'm sure you want the final exam results to reflect well on your efforts, as we do.
