W	7	9/5	<p>In class:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Test: Units 1-3 ➤ Unit 5 Practice <p>Hw #7:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Finish Unit 5 – Work thru p. 84 • Hand in drills 14-17, 19-22 and 24 • For drill 21, write the word that you hear. • For Drill 24, write an English translation for each of the noun phrases you write. • Learn the words on p. 82 and 83 (make a guess and then you can confirm it by skimming the glossary in the back of the book.) • Make flash cards for new vocabulary • Read the Arabic signs on your DVD in Unit 5. See how many of them you can read. • Read “Culture: Forms of Address” p. 85 and listen to scene 7 “tasharrafnaa”. Try to guess what the situation is and what the speakers are saying. We will practice in class Friday but you should listen at home to prepare for the in-class practice. • Using OLE, make a recording of yourself reading the words in Drill 17 p. 64. This is due by Friday (anytime, as long as it is posted on 9/7) Your posting should be no longer that 2 minutes. Practice reading the words enough times that you can read them accurately in this amount of time. Remember to make your long vowels long and your short vowels short. Exaggerate this! Imitate the DVD speaker in terms of when to use deep vs frontal vowels.
